### **Description Summary:**

The Anneslie Historic District is a suburban subdivision located east of York Road in Baltimore County, Maryland, immediately north of the Baltimore City line. The neighborhood developed during the period 1922-1961, and comprises 477 contributing resources representing a broad variety of residential types that characterize that period, including bungalow, cottage, Foursquare, Tudor, Colonial, and Cape Cod styles. A small cluster of commercial buildings is located at the western edge of the district.

### **General Description:**

The Anneslie subdivision, platted in 1922, comprises fourteen blocks of uniform lots, created by a grid of five streets extending eastward from York Road, a major thoroughfare connecting Baltimore City with the Baltimore County seat of Towson. The street pattern is overlaid upon topography which is flat in the northern section, but increasingly rolling in the southern part. At the western edge of the neighborhood, a small complex of commercial buildings developed along the east side of York Road, providing amenities for the community.

Generally speaking, development of Anneslie began in the northern and western area and proceeded to the south and east. Regester Avenue, Murdock, Anneslie, and Dunkirk roads are lined with bungalows, cottages, and Foursquares from the 1920s and 30s; more southerly streets such as Overbrook and Windwood are characterized by Tudors, Colonials, and Cape Cods from the 1930s through the 1950s. Villa Anneslie, the ca. 1855 Italian Villa which originally commanded the 119-acre tract, remains on a three-acre parcel on the south side of Dunkirk Road. Houses are uniformly set back from the street. Many of the properties include garages, detached or — in the southern part of the district, where topography is more irregular — at basement level.

The district is characterized by a variety of popular building types and architectural styles representing the period 1922-1961.

Many of the earliest houses in the neighborhood are Bungalows, generally of frame construction on a parged or rusticated block foundation, 1-1/2 stories in height, with an integral porch and a large front-facing dormer. Many of these bungalows remain clad in wood shingles or stucco.

The cubical, hip-roofed Foursquare house form appears infrequently in the district; noteworthy examples include 6701 York Road, a large brick Foursquare with Colonial Revival detailing; 513 Murdock Road, executed in rusticated concrete block with cast-stone porch columns; and 523 Anneslie, a smaller stucco Foursquare.

A number of eclectic Cottages are interspersed among the contemporaneous bungalows. Number 510 Dunkirk Road is a representative example, of frame construction, two stories in height with a broad front porch under an extension of its slate-clad gable roof, and a large shed dormer with two paired six-over-six sash across the façade. Number 519 is similar, and features slate sheathing its front dormer and an early porch enclosure with pebble-glass fanlights. Another example is 515 Anneslie Road, in stucco with a detached one-car garage.

Particularly noteworthy are several one-story stucco houses that reflect Mediterranean influence. Number 730 Anneslie Road is a flat-roofed, Spanish Mission style house with an attached garage framing a courtyard. A small house at 623 Anneslie Road was advertised by the builder as "A Home from Sunny Italy." A 1932 newspaper advertisement described 611 Anneslie Road as an "Insulated California Bungalow;" an arcaded porch spans its façade, and its low-pitched gable roof was originally clad in tile. Next door, 609 Anneslie Road remains much as it appeared in an illustration accompanying a 1932 advertisement, one story with a hipped roof and multiple projecting gables. Number 606 Anneslie Road is a one-story stucco cottage with a hipped roof that retains its original red tile. Adjacent on the east, 608 Anneslie Road is also a hip-roofed cottage, with arched window openings expressed in stucco detailing.

Several houses in Anneslie follow a model described by the builder as a "Colonial Bungalow," whose multiple front-facing gables actually seem more related to the Tudor style. A concentration of these houses occurs in the 700 block of Dunkirk Road. Number 726 was shown in a 1932 newspaper advertisement; across the street, number 725 presents a mirror image, and retains wood shingle siding and an open porch.

Tudor-style houses – typically of brick, often with stone detailing, and also frame and stucco – occur throughout the district. A particularly noteworthy concentration of 1930s Tudors is located on the north side of Anneslie Road in the 600 and 700 blocks. Similar Tudors are concentrated in the western blocks of Overbrook Road. These houses feature a steeply sloping roof, with a broad gable projection framing a round-arched doorway.

Several Colonial Revival houses of the 1920s and 30s occur in the northern part of the district. The southern part, especially along Overbrook and Windwood roads, comprises later Colonial-influenced houses, typically of brick, two stories in height, with center-hall or side-entrance plans.

The 1-1/2 story Cape Cod type occurs primarily in the southern part of the district, typically in brick. An early frame example is located at 709 Murdock Road, and a picturesque stone

veneered Cape Cod appears at 707 Overbrook Road. Several mid-century Cape Cods employ Contemporary design elements in their deep roof overhangs and large picture windows; examples include 706 and 704 Overbrook Road, and 721 Anneslie Road. More conservative 1950s brick Cape Cods are found elsewhere in the 700 block of Overbrook, and along Windwood Road.

Along York Road, a cluster of commercial buildings serves the community. Early free-standing one-story brick commercial buildings include 6801 (1925), 6811 (1935), and 6729 (1940). Larger two-story commercial blocks were built in the Post-WWII period, including 6705-21 (1947) and 6803-05 (1950). Still later office buildings – and commercial conversions of residential structures – appear in the 6500 and 6600 blocks.

The Anneslie Historic District retains a high degree of integrity. The overwhelming majority of the properties comprising the district clearly express their original form and massing, and most retain their period exterior materials and detailing. Alterations within the district are generally limited to the application of synthetic siding and replacement of windows. Some houses have been expanded with additions to the rear; in only a few cases are these additions so substantial as to compromise the integrity of the properties.

### **Summary Statement of Significance:**

The Anneslie Historic District is significant under Criterion A for its association with the early 20<sup>th</sup> century suburbanization of the York Road corridor north of the Baltimore City line. Beginning in the early 1920s and extending to mid-century, this area was the focus of considerable residential development thanks to its proximity to the city and easy access via streetcar and later automobile. Anneslie was one of three adjacent subdivisions that developed during this period. Offering detached houses of modest scale, Anneslie complemented its neighbors Stoneleigh to the north (1922; NR listed 2003), which offered somewhat larger houses and lot sizes, and Rodgers Forge to the west (1931; NR listed 2009), a community of brick rowhouses. It derives additional significance under Criterion C as a representative example of a type of early 20<sup>th</sup> century subdivision, characterized by uniform lots laid out in a gridiron plan. The neighborhood is primarily residential in character, and its properties reflect a variety of popular styles. Villa Anneslie, the Italianate mansion which was the centerpiece of the 119-acre tract prior to subdivision, remains in place among the later houses, a relatively rare surviving example of the rural retreats which characterized the York Road corridor in the latter half of the nineteenth century.

The Period of Significance begins in 1922 with the acquisition of the property by the Steffey Company and the creation of the subdivision plan, and ends in 1961, by which date the neighborhood was essentially fully developed.

### Resource History and Historic Context:

### HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

### **Baltimore County**

Baltimore County was named for Cecilius Calvert, the second Lord Baltimore of Maryland. Its territory consisted at one time of parts of Baltimore City, Cecil and Harford Counties, as well as Carroll, Anne Arundel, Frederick, Howard, and Kent. Though the exact date of its establishment is unknown, it was officially documented as a county in 1659. Baltimore Town, known now as Baltimore City, became the county seat in 1768, and eventually separated to form its own municipality in 1854. Baltimore County today has a total area of 682 square miles and a population of 763,000. It is bounded to the north by the Pennsylvania border, to the south by Anne Arundel County, to the northeast by Harford, to the southwest by Howard, and to the northwest by Carroll. Baltimore County is the most centrally located of Maryland's counties. Its proximity to the city of Baltimore greatly affected the development of the county over time and the eventual suburbanization and migration from the city in the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries.

As Baltimore County developed, the area between the city of Baltimore and the county seat at Towson became the site of country estates for prosperous Baltimoreans. York Road, an extension from Towson to Baltimore along which Anneslie sits, was laid out in 1799 as York Turnpike. The short distance along York Road between the city and county meant that wealthy residents could live and work in Baltimore and vacation at their rural estates just outside. This trend continued into the early 20<sup>th</sup> century when developers began marketing county suburban neighborhoods, like Anneslie, as a way to live in the country with the benefits of rural life, and travel into the city to work.

#### Villa Anneslie

The origins of Anneslie can be traced to Lord Baltimore and the Howard family, when a tract of wooded land was granted by Lord Baltimore to Govane Howard. The land grant was known as Drumqhazel and a home was built by Howard in what is now the Anneslie area, though it burned sometime in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. A Baltimore importer named Robert Brown purchased 230 acres of land in 1850 from Philip R. Howard to build his own estate, known as Stoneleigh Villa. He subsequently sold 119-acres of that tract to his brother-in-law Frederick Harrison.

Harrison, a native of Connecticut, was a land surveyor and a government engineer who worked as an assistant to Dr. William Howard in Baltimore. He began building his estate off York Road, adjacent to Stoneleigh Villa, in 1855 as a country home for his family, and named the property Villa Anneslie. There is some dispute among historians whether the name was an homage to his wife or his daughter, both named Anne.

Villa Anneslie and Stoneleigh Villa were designed by the architect John Rudolph Niernsee, of the architectural firm Niernsee and Nielson in Baltimore. Known for his romantic and Italianate designs, Niernsee was responsible for a number of well-known estates throughout the Baltimore area, including Clifton, Dumbarton, and possibly Wyman Villa in Baltimore City. As stated in the National Register Nomination for Villa Anneslie, "though the house is not exceptionally elaborate, the architect closely followed A.J. Downing's designs. Niernsee's asymmetrical design with a central tower over the entrance and his floor plan can be readily found in Downing's books"—specifically Design XXII, "Villa in the Italian Style," in Downing's <u>The Architecture of Country Houses</u> (1850).

The Stoneleigh Villa estate was purchased by the Stoneleigh Corporation in 1922 and subdivided and the house torn down in 1955. Villa Anneslie survives as it did in the mid-19<sup>th</sup> century. It is one of only three country estate houses which have endured the commercial and residential development along York Road, between Baltimore City and Towson.

(Although Villa Anneslie is architecturally significant in its own right, and represents a rare surviving example of a country estate in the area, it is not directly related to the themes which constitute the

district's significance, and its construction predates the Period of Significance for the district. Villa Anneslie was individually listed in the National Register in 1977.)

#### Suburbanization in the U.S.

Planned suburbs began to appear as early as the 1850's, in places like Llewellyn Park, New Jersey (1857) and Riverside, Illinois (1869). Similar to country estates, they offered a haven from overcrowding in the cities while providing many of the amenities that made urban life so appealing. The National Park Service defines a historic residential suburb as:

A geographic area, usually located outside the central city, that was historically connected to the city by one or more modes of transportation; subdivided and developed primarily for residential use according to a plan; and possessing a significant concentration, linkage, and continuity of dwellings on small parcels of land, roads and streets, utilities, and community facilities.

The estates of Stoneleigh and Anneslie were close enough to the city of Baltimore to allow for daily travel, but without the noise, congestion, and pollution that plagued metropolitan areas in the 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries.

The National Park Service Bulletin on historic residential suburbs identifies four major types of suburbs, defined largely by the mode of transportation available at the time. These include: railroad and horsecar suburbs, 1830-1890, streetcar suburbs, 1888-1928, early automobile suburbs, 1908-1945, and Post-WWII and early highway suburbs, 1945-1960. Anneslie can be defined as both a streetcar suburb and an early automobile suburb, as both played a role in its structure and development.

### **Transportation Trends**

Transportation trends in Baltimore County at the turn of the century greatly advanced travel and the opportunity to live in one place and work in another. In 1895, York Road became Route 8 in the electric streetcar line that ran from Towson to Catonsville. The line served York Road, Greenmount Avenue, and Frederick Road into the city. The United Railways and Electric Company operated in the Baltimore metro area from 1899 to 1935. It was eventually replaced by the Baltimore Transit Company.

Streetcars offered inexpensive transportation that encouraged low- and middle- income families to relocate out of cities. Streetcar suburbs formed continuous corridors along route lines.<sup>9</sup>

By 1930, the automobile had become a competitor to the streetcar. In *United Railways v. Public Service Commission of Maryland* (1930), the railway applied to raise fares for transit service arguing that the use of street cars had declined since the introduction of the automobile, and the company did not have enough business to compensate its expenses.<sup>10</sup>

Charles Steffey may have anticipated the eventual use of automobiles in Anneslie for both work and leisure; Sanborn Maps from June 1929 show that about one of every two residences had a detached garage.

In the United States, automobile registration between 1910 and 1930 increased from 458,000 to 22 million. The mass production of cars all but eliminated the need for such services as the electric streetcar and suburban developments began to reflect the change in transportation trends towards cars. Attached and unattached garages became more common place, businesses and factories were able to move outside the city, and materials like asphalt (introduced in 1890s) became the common surface for roads by the 1920s. 12

#### **ANNESLIE**

Anneslie was the conception of real estate developer Charles H. Steffey. Undoubtedly influenced by the efforts of Edward Bouton and the construction of neighborhoods like Roland Park and Guilford, Steffey was a part of an emerging group of professionals known as "community builders." According to the National Park Service, "The term 'community builder' came into use in the first decade of the twentieth century in connection with the city planning movement and the development of large planned residential neighborhoods."

These neighborhoods were designed through the collaborative efforts of developers, site planners, engineers, architects, and landscape architects. The streets, lots, and public spaces were carefully selected, platted, and designed to reflect a particular aesthetic or to attract a certain type of homeowner. Deed restrictions and neighborhood covenants were then implemented to ensure that the developer would maintain control of their design even as the properties were sold.<sup>13</sup>

#### Survey

In 1922, Steffey purchased all but three acres of the Villa Anneslie estate from Lennox Birckhead. Birckhead acquired the property from his father, also named Lennox Birckhead, who had married the daughter of Frederick Harrison. <sup>14</sup> The mansion remained in the Birckhead family until 1972. Lennox was an active member of the Anneslie Community Association, a neighborhood cooperative formed in 1926 which later became the non-profit group Anneslie Community, Inc. in 1944. <sup>15</sup>

Charles Steffey and the Steffey Corporation created neighborhoods like Ten Hills in Baltimore County (1910) and Admiral Heights in Annapolis (1937). A plat of Anneslie, surveyed by F.D. Dollenberg, was filed with the Baltimore County Land Records Office on May 25, 1922. The survey shows Anneslie consisting of 1,069 lots, 23 blocks, a setback for each lot of 25 feet, and an average lot size of 125 x 50

feet. The plan is laid as a grid over rolling topography. This differed from the landscape design of nearby Stoneleigh, which responded to the natural slopes and curves of the topography.

Though Villa Anneslie and the three acres it sits on were not purchased by Steffey, and still exists today in its same location, the estate is not included in the 1922 plat. This suggests that perhaps there were plans at one time to purchase the remaining three acres and subdivide the property, as occurred with Stoneleigh Villa in 1955.

Ten Hills, like Anneslie, was once part of a country estate in Baltimore County. Charles Steffey hired civil engineers Augustus Bouldin and Co. to design and develop the landscape and street plan, with the intention of creating a natural and picturesque streetscape. Whereas in Anneslie the plan was laid very simply as a grid overtop the rolling terrain, with no awareness of the landscape, the market in Ten Hills (as in Stoneleigh) was for a higher income homeowner and buyers would have appealed for a more picturesque, romantic design.

#### **Development**

Steffey apparently constructed at least a limited number of houses on speculation, unlike similar subdivisions where lots were sold without improvements. Most of the homes in Anneslie vary little in size and style; buyers chose designs within the framework of the architectural styles already selected and those pre-determined by design covenants for the neighborhood. Similarly in Ten Hills, deed covenant design guidelines were used by owners and their architects or builders to choose the type of home they wanted. The early architecture in Ten Hills consists mostly of Georgian, Tudor and Foursquare homes on ½ acre lots. 18

Covenants and restrictions in Anneslie were used to control the aesthetic of the neighborhood as well as to prevent certain uses and exclude certain residents. In a deed dated October 10, 1925 from Charles H. Steffey, Inc. to John L. Hogarth and Mary A. Hogarth, for the transfer of lots 23 and 24 Block "N", the following restrictions were included,

To wit no building shall be erected on said lots nearer than twenty five feet to the front line of said lots [.] No house shall be erected on said lots which shall cost less than thirty five hundred dollars [.] No house to be erected on any lot of less than fifty feet front [.] This property shall never be rented or sold to or for the use of persons of the negro race [.] No intoxicating liquors shall ever be manufactured or sold on said premises [.]

Covenants like these were a way for developers to ensure that the character of the neighborhood and clientele for whom the neighborhood was intended would be maintained as lots were sold and properties transferred to new owners.

#### Marketing and Finance

All modern amenities like gas, water, electricity, telephone, telegraph, and sewer were included with the lots from the beginning. By 1923, the lots were fully equipped with the most up-to-date public services and buyers were guaranteed a home with working utilities upon purchase.<sup>19</sup>

A marketing advertisement for Anneslie published by Charles Steffey, Inc. around 1929 describes the benefits of living in this new neighborhood:

Anneslie was opened in June 1922, and there are now over 160 homes there. They have water, gas, electricity, sewage, sidewalks, fire plugs, street lights, all macadam or concrete roads with be laid, and - best of all-there are county taxes. It has been restricted to cottage type homes, with no house built on a lot less than 50 feet front. This protects your investment against the crowding in of row houses and assures you that the beauty of the property will be maintained, a suburban development with open lawns, flowers and trees....In short, you find here a country home with every city advantage.

The Steffey Corporation marketed Anneslie by running advertisements in newspapers, like the Baltimore Sun, distributing brochures, and holding open houses. Advertisements were geared towards families looking for an affordable and attractive place to live. "Young couples, just starting out; families with children who want to get ahead; thrifty folk who want to get most out of living and will not squander their money." 20

Home ownership at this time in the United States became a priority for many families who could only afford to rent, and Anneslie was painted as a first class neighborhood accessible to nearly everyone. It held the best of both worlds- exclusivity without the costs of being exclusive. To ensure the affordability of homes, Steffey encouraged mortgages to help homebuyers finance the purchase of their property.

For a stucco bungalow located on Anneslie Road, listed at \$5,775, Steffey advertised that the property could be purchased for just a \$500 cash payment. To accomplish this, the homebuyer must obtain a Building and Loan Association mortgage of \$4,056 and a second mortgage of \$1,219. Weekly payments could be as low as \$17.92.<sup>21</sup>

Advertisements also stressed the proximity of Anneslie to local schools, the Towson business district, churches, parks, and the Hillendale and Rodgers Forge Golf Clubs. <sup>22</sup> In an interview conducted with current resident Jim Dobson, former President of the Anneslie Community Association, many of the same reasons were given for why homebuyers still find Anneslie such a desirable neighborhood. He noted the great school system, proximity to the city of Baltimore, and the number of activities available

to residents; activities that today include: Anneslie Community Association, Boy Scouts, a community website and newsletter, holiday decorating contest, neighborhood block parties and annual picnics, and a citizen patrol.


